Austin is an early to medium early processing potato variety which has an excellent suitability for production of crisps and French Fries.



SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT AUSTIN:



- Rapid early growth
- Presprouted and covered with foil can allow very early harvest
- Good tolerance for periods of drought and heat
- Guaranteed good dry matter
- Resistance to Y-virus
- Resistance against nematodes Ro1, 4 (9) and wart disease Fysio 1 (10); 6 (slightly susceptible)

Maturity: Early to medium early. **Tuber Shape:** Round-oval, rather shallow eyes, light yellow flesh color. **Processing:** Excellent suitability for crisps- and French fries production, very low content of acrylamide even after long term storage. **Yield:** high; high dry matter content.
