



Montis is a very high yielding, medium early variety with a yellow flesh color. Due to its very long uniform tubers and excellent frying texture it is well suited for the production of French Fries.



SOME INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT MONTIS:

- Consistently very high yield with low nitrogen input
- High Tolerance against Phytophtora infestans
- Good tolerance to periods of drought and heat
- High number of big sized tubers
- Very high resistance to hollow heart

- Homogenous tuber shape and size
- Well suited for long term storage with excellent frying colors

LOW INPUT

- Resistance against nematodes Ro 1, 4 (9)
- Resistance against wart disease Fysio 1 (10)

Maturity: medium early. **Tuber Shape:** long shape with shallow eyes, yellow skin and flesh color. **Processing:** Ideally suited for the processing of French Fries, mealy cooking type. **Yield:** very high.
