

CLASSIC RUSSET



CLASSIC RUSSET is an early to medium early variety with a white flesh color. It produces very large and uniformly grown tubers with a long-oval tuber shape. These advantages combined with a very good yield are making CLASSIC RUSSET very interesting for the production of French Fries.

Some interesting facts about CLASSIC RUSSET:

- Highly tolerant against internal defects
- Uniform tuber shape with a high percentage of big tubers
- Low content of glycoalkaloids
- Resistance against wart disease fysis 1
- Suitable for fresh processing and short term storage
- Moderate susceptible for bruising
- Moderate content of dry matter
- Moderate tolerance against common scab
