

MISS MALINA



Miss MALINA is a medium early, yellow fleshed variety with a long shaped tuber ideally suited for the industrial processing of French Fries. It is also well suited for use as a firm to fairly firm table potato. Miss MALINA is distinguished by its very nice yellow flesh colour and a very uniform and long tuber shape.

Some interesting facts about MISS MALINA:

- Resistant to all pathotypes of *Globodera rostochiensis*
- Extremely low susceptibility to foliage blight and tuber rots
- Moderate susceptibility to damages and bruising
- Very good resistance to common scab
- Extremely low susceptibility to PVY and PVR
- Strong dormancy makes it ideal for long term storage



Maturity:	medium early
Tuber shape:	long, with very shallow eyes, light-yellow skin and yellow flesh, nice tuber shape
Processing:	Ideally suited for the processing of French Fries, also suitable as a fairly firm cooking table potato
